Swinomish Stick Games **RULES**

*NO DRUGS OR ALCOHOL, Anyone under the influence, the entire team will be disqualified.

*No thumb guessing, no fake guessing, no pointing with stick, may use bones to guess.

*Hinder must show bones on last stick. First guess is final.

*Three minutes to hide bones, three minutes to guess, 15 minute break in between games.

*One main guesser through-out the tournament, any team member may 2nd guess.

*Swinomish Tribe or Stick Game Committee is not responsible for theft, injury, or shortage of funds.

*Play at your own risk!

*3-5 players, no age limit, must have knowledge of the game.

*All players must be there at the start of each game.

*All disputes will be handled by Stick Game Committee. If there is a dispute, stop the game and let Committee handle it. Do not wait until the game is over because it will count as a loss.
